

Decree



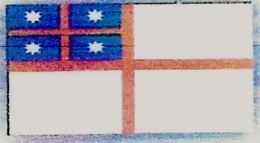
TO HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH II, BRITISH CROWN, UNITED NATIONS, GOVERNMENT OF NEW ZEALAND, SUBJECTS, AND CITIZENS

In accordance with HE WHAKAPUTANGA O NGA RANGATIRA O NU TIRENI 1835, these letters;
Letter Rogatory to her Majesty's Governor-General of New Zealand, 18th Sept 2008AD,
Public Proclamation Declaration to Her Majesty's Government of New Zealand, 26th Sept 2008AD,
Edict Declaration to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II dated 30th Sept 2008AD,
form part of this Decree. And;

Having full sovereign power and authority within the territories of the
United Tribes of New Zealand/"Ko te Whakaminenga O Nga Hapu O Nu Tireni."
We shall not permit any legislative Government Authority separate from ourselves unless by
persons appointed by us and acting under the authority laws/lores enacted by us in Congress
assembled for the purpose of framing laws/lores for the dispensation of justice,
the preservation of peace, good order and the regulation of trade.

HEREBY PROCLAIM

1. The Hereditary Chiefs, Heads of Tribes and Rangatira of the United Tribes of New Zealand, appoints **Matiu Kauri Tuhourangi Tarawa** as the first Governor for NEW ZEALAND since Captain William Hobson RN.
2. The Governor shall appoint an interim Bank Governor and Secretary of State for the United Tribes of New Zealand until the hereditary Chiefs, Heads of Tribes and Rangatira meet in congress at Waitangi to appoint a new Governor, Bank Governor, Secretary of State and other such Emissaries for the legislative authority of the United Tribes of New Zealand.
3. The Governor shall recover all Registered Certificates of Land Title for the Unextinguished Native Title, to be held in the Registry of the United Tribes of New Zealand, and our Registry shall be recognised by the United Nations as the only authorised Land Registry.
4. The Governor shall recover all Tangata Whenua Birth Certificates of Title to be held in the Registry of the United Tribes of New Zealand, and our Registry shall be recognised by the United Nations as the only authorised Registry.
5. The Governor shall ensure recognition by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, the British Crown and United Nations, of the Native Indigenous Bank for the United tribes of New Zealand, our unique currency and to provide connectivity to interchange, settlement and clearing and allowing global FOREX transactions and for the recovery of our Native Indigenous Funds held in Trust.
6. The Governor shall investigate all documented cases of judicial injustice and repugnancy committed by Her Majesty's Ministers, their Agents and the Police, to provide remedy and recourse for those injured Rangatira, Whanau and Hapu being the Native Indigenous people of the United Tribes of New Zealand, in accordance with Tikanga Maori.
7. The Governor shall replace Her Majesty's New Zealand Government flag with HE WHAKAPUTANGA O NGA RANGATIRA O NU TIRENI 1835 flag as acknowledged by His Majesty King William IV.



COVENANT OF APPOINTMENT



Governor having accepted the Appointment makes his Covenant.

I promise Io Matua Kore, to govern Her Majesty's Ministers, Subjects and Citizens according to HE WHAKAPUTANGA O NGA RANGATIRA O NU TIRENI 1835.

I shall uphold the feudal and fudicial titles binding the British Crown before and after 20th July 2008AD when PM Gordon Brown Signed the Lisbon Treaty, to the reciprocal obligations of service and defense using the United Kingdom and New Zealand forces, in protection of Tangata Whenua, Nga Rangatira and Hapu according to the Standing Orders of Lord Glenelg to Major General Bourke in May 1836 and Letters Patent issued by Lord Normanby to Captain Hobson in August 1839.


I shall ensure to protect the Hereditary Chiefs, Heads of Tribes and Rangatira of the United Tribes of New Zealand / 'Ko te Whakaminenga O Nga Hapu O Nu Tireni' within the terms of Te Tiriti O Waitangi 1840 and in accordance with Tikanga Maori.

I shall ensure that all New Zealand Government Ministers, Subjects and Servants shall promise their Oath of Alligence to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II her bloodline heirs being heir to the British Crown.


I shall recognise the positions of the [Governor], [Bank Governor] and [Secretary of State] all having agreed to this Covenant of Appointment.


This Covenant of my Appointment I promise, ensure and recongise, I shall perform and keep, so help me Io Matua Kore.

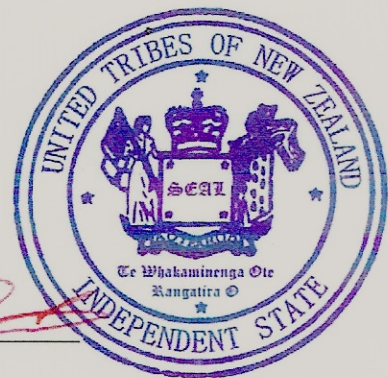
